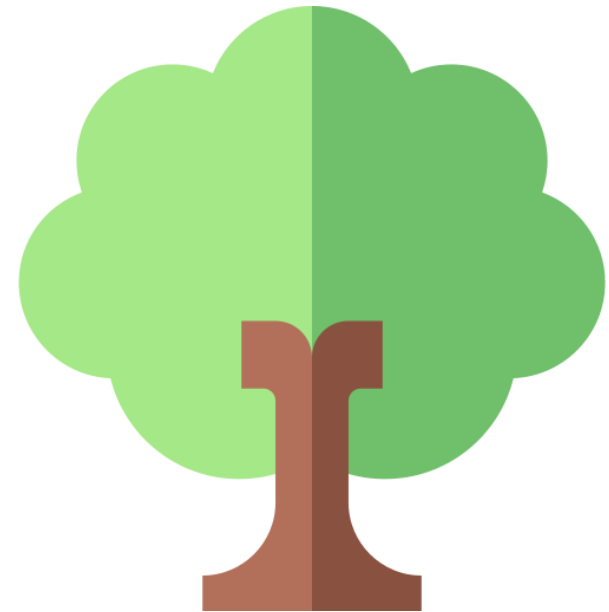

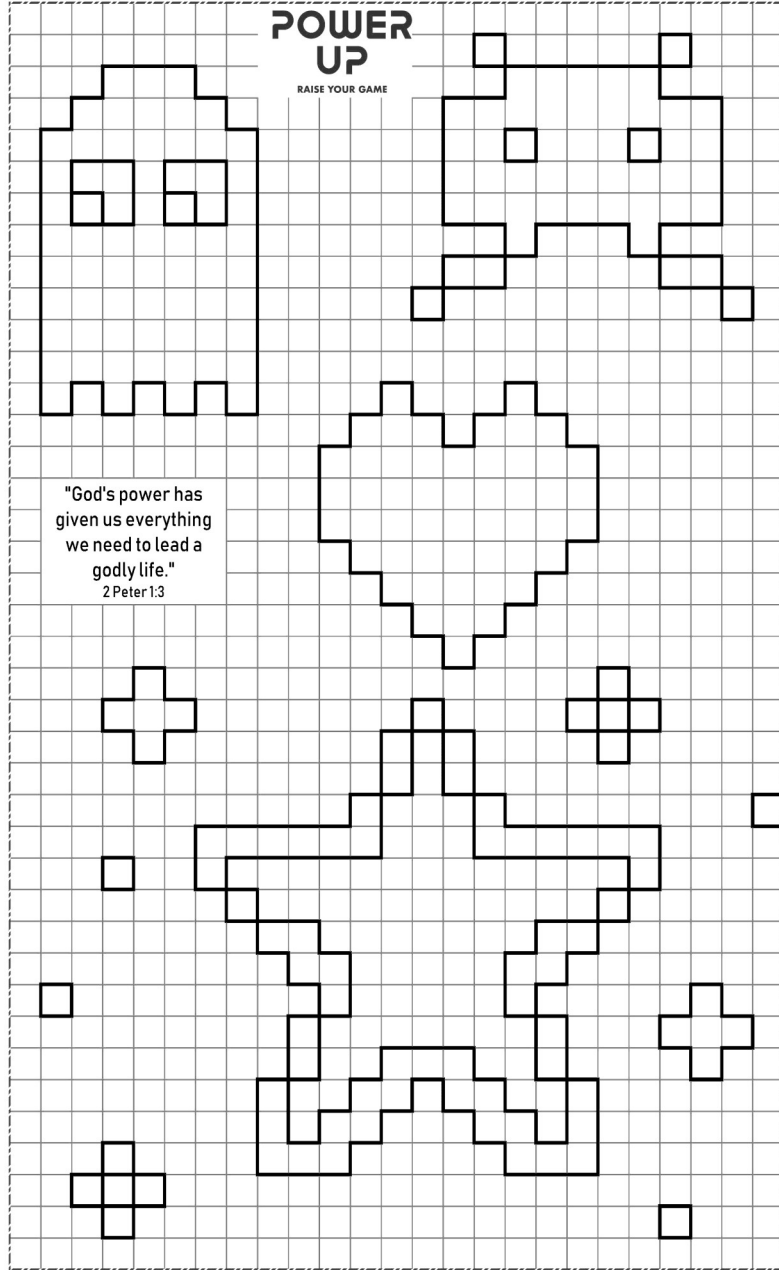

Take a minute to clear your mind and focus on God. Is there something in the park that reminds you of God's power to do the impossible? What is it?

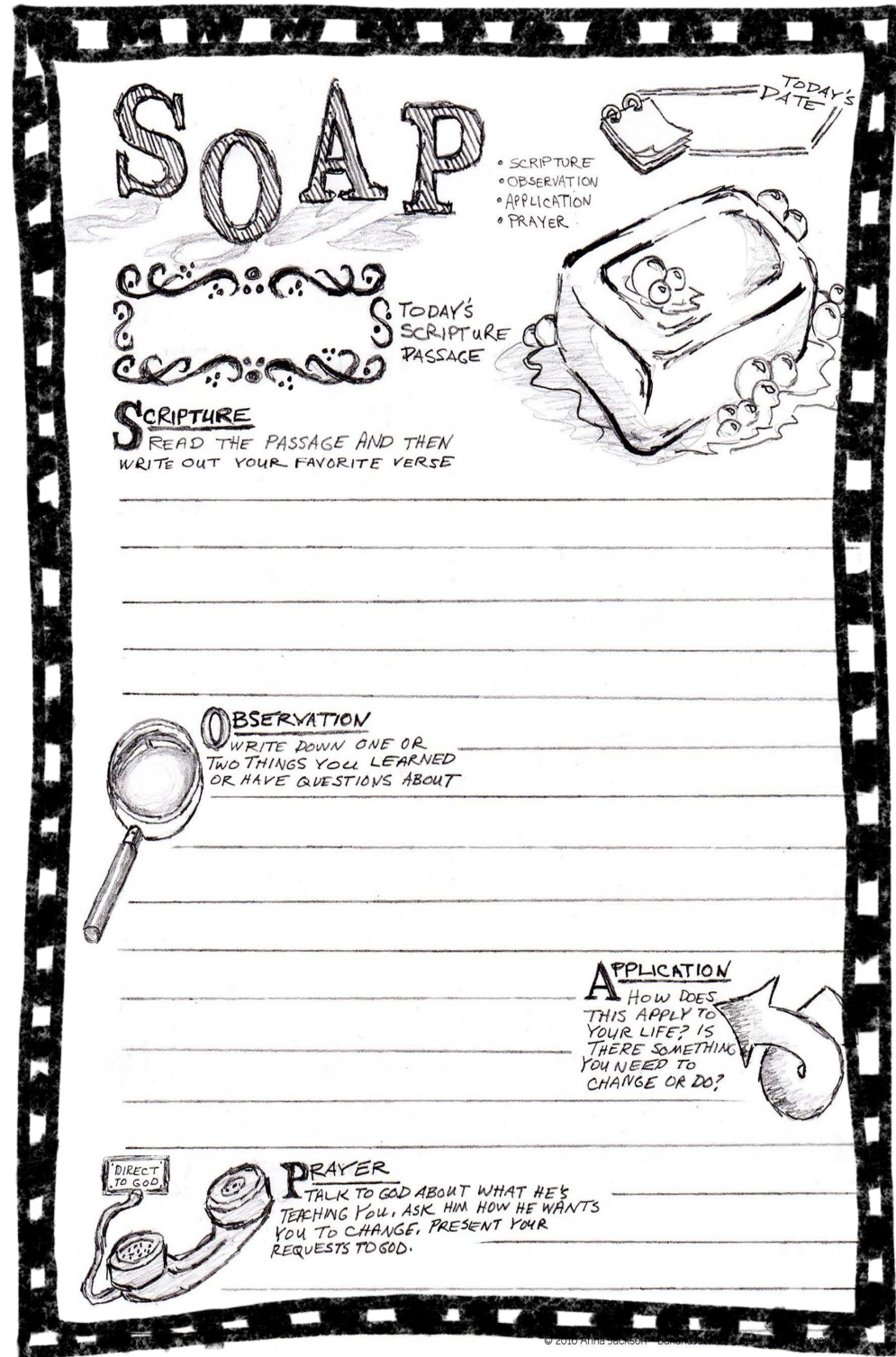
Eye spy with my little eye something that has five fingers but isn't a hand. What is it?

**We sing to praise God. We can praise God with our bodies. Can you spin in a circle? Can you jump high in the air?**








**We are in the season of fall! Can you make a pumpkin with playdough?**
